The Scottish Goldsmiths' Trust has the aim of helping to increase the public's knowledge, understanding and appreciation of art, design and craft with particular reference to British gold and silver and hallmarking.

The Trustees will normally consider applications for support from the limited funds available for disbursement in March and September each year. Applications should be submitted on a pro-forma available from the Director and returned to her by 28th February for consideration in the March round and by 31st August for consideration in the September round.

The Trustees will normally consider only one application per year from any one individual or organisation.

The Trustees seek to encourage innovative and imaginative initiatives which meet their aims and objectives.

The Trustees welcome projects which seek funding for one year or spread over two years or exceptionally over three years. They are generally reluctant to enter into long running commitments or to support the same initiative or project over a number of years.

The Trustees welcome applications which identify other sources of support which have been secured or sought.

The Trustees welcome projects which aim to become self-sustaining.

The Trustees will make it a condition of support that the beneficiaries keep them informed of progress with the initiative or project and report back on the outcomes achieved once the funding has ended and the project has been realised.
